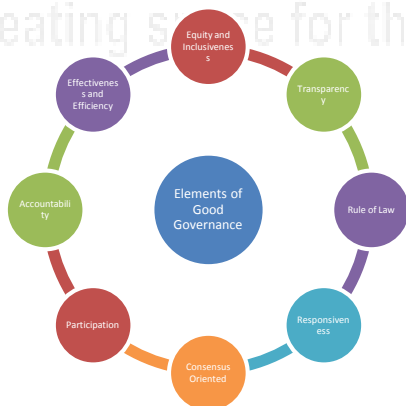

Q: Give three ideas for digitalization that will be of benefit to the citizens. State these ideas in context of Pakistan.

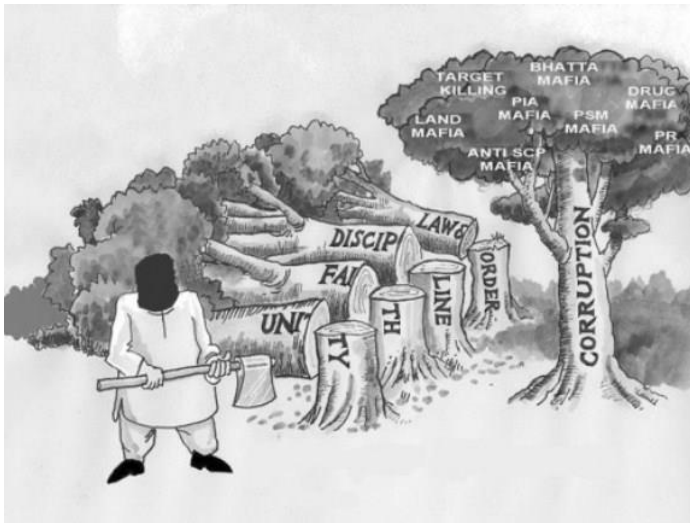
